On November 25th, 2025, I took a report for a sexual assault incident. At approximately 10:00AM, the victim, [REDACTED] met with myself and Detective Sgt. Maurer at the Delaware County Sheriff's Office at 1776 State Route 521 in Delaware to provide her statement. [REDACTED] was accompanied by lawyers [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

Before the interview with [REDACTED] attorney [REDACTED] had spoken with me briefly in the hallway regarding [REDACTED] and the suspect, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] had advised me that [REDACTED] had been experiencing anxiety from the incident and this had has an impact on her mental health as of recently. [REDACTED] also showed me a screenshot of a few text messages between [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] where [REDACTED] was apologizing for "pressuring and scaring" [REDACTED] with his actions, and that he had admitted to finally understand what she was asking of him after she had repeatedly told him "over and over" again.

I then conducted the interview with [REDACTED] with her two attorneys present. I started the interview by reassuring [REDACTED] that I wanted to hear her story in the most organic form, and not to feel pressured. I asked [REDACTED] first where the incident between her and [REDACTED] occurred. [REDACTED] responded that it was a complicated question, as there were multiple incidents in different locations. [REDACTED] did confirm that they all occurred within Delaware County. [REDACTED] stated there were incident at her old apartment in [REDACTED] Delaware, In [REDACTED] within the Delaware County Courthouse, and her new apartment [REDACTED].

I advised [REDACTED] to start from the beginning, and she advised that she started [REDACTED] at the Delaware County prosecutor's office. She had met [REDACTED] during that time, but had not had many interactions with him until she was officially sworn in [REDACTED] for Delaware County in November of 2024.

During the same time period of November 2024, [REDACTED] completed a jury trial [REDACTED] days after she had been sworn in. It was recommended by her co-workers that she meet with [REDACTED] after the jury trial to get feedback, as this was common practice. [REDACTED] had a meeting with [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] regarding the trial, but [REDACTED] primarily asked about [REDACTED] personal life and asked if she was single. [REDACTED] stated there was some trial feedback mentioned, but he focused mostly on asking her personal questions. [REDACTED] told her that she seemed like a "fun girl" and that he wanted to get to know her better. [REDACTED] stated it continued on from there, as

█████ would seek her out at work to speak with her and when she volunteered at the board of elections, he showed up just to see her.

In the month of January of 2025, █████ attended a bar association meeting and he sat next to her. She and █████ spoke one on one, and again he asked her more personal questions like, "Do you have a boyfriend?" and "Why don't you have a boyfriend?" █████ stated that around this time, her friends had started noticing █████ odd interactions with her.

In either January or February of 2025, █████ visited the Delaware County prosecutor's office with another prosecutor, but ended up stopping by █████ office. █████ stayed in her office for so long, that other prosecutors had checked in and asked if he was leaving soon. Another prosecutor jokingly texted her asking if they were going to need wine, and to tell █████ to leave. █████ just continued to ask █████ personal questions the entire time he was there. █████ stated that as a result of his odd behavior in her office, █████ was required by Melissa Schiffel to schedule a time with her if he would like to visit the prosecutor's office. This rule appeared to only apply to █████

In March of 2025, █████ attended the swearing in of Judge Mark Fowler for the Delaware County Municipal Court. █████ was present for the swearing in as well. █████ stated she knew Mark Fowler's family, who was also present for the event. █████ was speaking to the Fowler family when █████ had approached her and jokingly "shoulder checked" her in front of the Fowler family. He then asked for her cell phone number so that he could contact her regarding the bar association meetings, and █████ provided him her number. █████ advised they started texting back and forth, and sometime after that, their relationship became physical.

█████ stated that he would ask to come to her apartment, and told her that everything was between them and that they were not to tell anyone what they were doing. █████ started asking her about sexual preferences and how many sexual partners she had. █████ then told █████ that if she ever wanted to have sex, she would have to initiate it with him, he could not initiate it with her. █████ advised that at first, she laughed it off.

Around April of 2025, █████ stated she believes that this was the first time █████ had come to her apartment. █████ stated it evolved from there, and he started inviting her up to █████. Sometime during the month, █████ texted her stating that he made a Snapchat account just to speak with her because he knew the messages would disappear. He also mentioned trying to seek out other platforms to communicate with █████

On May 12th of 2025, █████ had plans to meet one of her male friends from law school. █████ told █████ of her plans, and █████ had called her and advised how angry and upset he was with her about seeing another man. █████ still went out to dinner with her friend that night, despite █████ reaction. █████ said later that night, she and her friend had stopped at the UDF and grabbed a pop, and they parked and sat at the parking lot on Union Street behind the courthouse until her friend had to leave. █████ stated that at this time, █████ already had her location via the iPhone application "find my friends". Due to the location sharing, █████ knew that █████ was near

the courthouse that night and drove to the courthouse. Around 10:00pm [REDACTED] went inside the courthouse to [REDACTED] and texted her to meet him inside. [REDACTED] met him inside his office, and [REDACTED] continued to rehash what he had been angry about earlier in that he was upset she was seeing someone else. [REDACTED] was questioning her on if she had sex with this other male, and wanted to know what they did. While speaking with [REDACTED] the other male tried to FaceTime [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] told her to open it so the male could see that she and [REDACTED] were together. [REDACTED] did not answer the FaceTime. [REDACTED] stated they continued to argue and she started crying. [REDACTED] stated it was late, and was now into the early hours of May 13th, and she stated she needed to leave. [REDACTED] was in a chair on the other side of [REDACTED] office, and when she got up to leave, he followed her. [REDACTED] then grabbed both of her arms with his hands, and turned her around to face him. [REDACTED] kept a hold of her arms, and pushed her into the wall. [REDACTED] tried to kiss her, but she faced away from him and he started kissing her neck. [REDACTED] still had the UDF pop in one hand, and her purse in the other hand. With both of her hands full, she tried to put her hands up and she turned away from him. [REDACTED] started undoing her belt and pants, and pulled her down to the floor. [REDACTED] continued to undo her pants, and undressed her from the waist down. [REDACTED] started to perform oral sex on her, and she stated she doesn't know how long it lasted, maybe a few minutes, but she could not recall. At some point, [REDACTED] turned so his back against the wall and pulled her toward him while he sat on the floor. [REDACTED] pulled his penis out of his pants and placed his hand on the back of her head to have her perform oral sex on him. [REDACTED] stated he kept his hand either on her head or neck during the incident. [REDACTED] said that [REDACTED] did not finish to completion as she pushed away from him and got up to quickly redressed herself. [REDACTED] then left and went home, and [REDACTED] did not follow her or try to stop her from leaving. [REDACTED] said she remembers feeling so shocked and caught off guard. [REDACTED] stated she couldn't understand how he could watch her cry and be in an emotional state talking to him, and suddenly try to have sex with her.

[REDACTED] stated that there was not much communication between them during the sexual assault incident. When it began, [REDACTED] didn't say anything and he just started kissing her. [REDACTED] said she doesn't remember saying anything to him, she was just waiting for it to be over. When it ended, [REDACTED] just stopped and pushed him away. She redressed herself, and she tried to joke it off and say, "I have to go home." Just after she left the office, [REDACTED] sent her a Snapchat. [REDACTED] did not open the message, and [REDACTED] then sent her a text message of a photo of her UDF pop that she had left on the floor.

A few days after the sexual assault incident, [REDACTED] texted [REDACTED] stating, "I went back and looked at your little mental health visit the other night" referring to the night of May 12th. [REDACTED] sent [REDACTED] a video that he took of the surveillance video of [REDACTED] leaving his office during the early hours of May 13th. [REDACTED] stated that night after the incident, she exited his office and smiled and said, "I have to go" to try and appear normal so that she could leave. She stated that when [REDACTED] looked back at the security camera days later, he noticed her smile on camera and told her through text that he saw it.

[REDACTED] stated they continued to talk a little bit after that, and he sent her another text telling her that he was

actively watching her on the security camera walking down the ramp and that she "didn't look good".

Later in May/beginning of June, [REDACTED] went on a vacation with his family. [REDACTED] stated he had called and texted almost the entire time, and had even stayed back from some of the family activities so that he could talk to [REDACTED]. Throughout the vacation he constantly asked [REDACTED] when he could come over once he got back from vacation.

Early June of 2025, [REDACTED] got back from vacation and asked about coming over. [REDACTED] called him and advised that she was done with "whatever this is" and advised him that the way that he was reacting was overwhelming. [REDACTED] stated she did not want to do anything physical with him anymore. In response, [REDACTED] would tell her that she's not attracted to him anymore, and asked her what did he do to make himself unattractive to her, and asked her why she did not want to have sex with him. [REDACTED] stated it was almost always geared toward sex. As soon as he got back from vacation, [REDACTED] then asked if he could come over before he went to work, as he had done that before. The night before, [REDACTED] told him he could come over, but she asked him if he was going to be mad at her if she told him that they were not going to have sex. [REDACTED] asked her if this was because of another guy, but [REDACTED] said no. [REDACTED] then comes over to her apartment [REDACTED] the next morning before work, and climbs into bed with [REDACTED] as she was still sleeping. [REDACTED] immediately tries to initiate sex with her and started pulling on her clothing. [REDACTED] positioned himself behind her and tried to "grind on her". [REDACTED] told him no several times and pushed herself away from him, but [REDACTED] still continued to try to initiate sex. [REDACTED] asked why he kept trying to initiate sex even when she said no, and he told her that he thought he could change her mind. [REDACTED] stated this occurred for almost 20 minutes where he continuously tried to have sex with her. [REDACTED] touched her breasts and vaginal area underneath her clothing and continuously groped her during this time, however he did not cause penetration. [REDACTED] would push him away, and then he continued to grope her again underneath the clothing. Eventually [REDACTED] got up and stated she had to go to work, and [REDACTED] lingered around her apartment.

[REDACTED] stated they had multiple conversations saying that if she says no to sex, that he cannot keep trying to initiate it. [REDACTED] stated when she told him no, he would get really emotional.

Around mid-June of 2025, there was continuation in their conversations, and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reached out to her and told her that he could help her with some mock interviews. [REDACTED] went to [REDACTED] after work and they started to discuss the mock interview, but [REDACTED] started talking about wanting to have sex. [REDACTED] tried to kiss her, but she told him no. [REDACTED] started getting emotional, and [REDACTED] felt she could not get it through his head that he cannot change her mind when she says no to sex.

[REDACTED] later sent her an apology text message stating that he was sorry about scaring her and pressuring her and stated that he wanted another chance. [REDACTED] stated he sent more messages like this via other social media platforms, but since she blocked him on everything she could not access it. [REDACTED] stated the interactions started to slow down after that.

Late June of 2025, [REDACTED] attended a bar association meeting and [REDACTED] was present. [REDACTED] and another prosecutor went to the restaurant called 1808 in Delaware afterwards, and [REDACTED] showed up with friend of his who was also at the bar association meeting. [REDACTED] thinks [REDACTED] either overheard her talking about going to 1808, or her friend had told him that's where they were going, as she wasn't expecting him to be there. [REDACTED] kept calling her sexy, and she told him that was inappropriate, but claimed that no one noticed him compliment her.

In July of 2025, [REDACTED] had attended [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] had asked Melissa Schiffel if it would be weird if he went to watch [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did not go, but he watched it via the live stream, and he sent [REDACTED] a recording of her on the live stream and sent it to her showing that he was watching it.

At the end of July 2025, [REDACTED] was asked if she wanted to move from her current position [REDACTED], to the [REDACTED] due to a new opening. [REDACTED] accepted the offer, and advised [REDACTED] that she accepted a new position [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] responded in anger, and stated this was going to jeopardize their ability to communicate all of the time. [REDACTED] stated she was not going to decline a new position at work just because of him. [REDACTED] stated he later sent her a text apologizing for his behavior.

In August of 2025, [REDACTED] had made it known to co-workers that she wanted to live in downtown Delaware. [REDACTED] knew someone that had a rental apartment downtown Delaware and sent her their contact information. [REDACTED] was able to rent the apartment downtown, and [REDACTED] stated that she owed him a favor for helping her get her dream apartment. He made comments about "I can think of a few ways I want to cash in my debt" and he was indirectly implying sexual favors.

In late September 2025, in her new apartment [REDACTED], [REDACTED] asked to come over and possibly stay the night as his family was out of town. [REDACTED] told him he could come over, but they were only to talk and he could not stay the night. He came over and they had dinner. [REDACTED] sat in a chair across from her as she sat on her couch. [REDACTED] got up and sat next to her on the couch and tried to touch her again. [REDACTED] got up and confronted him and asked him why he thinks he can do this to her when she tells him no. [REDACTED] started crying and threw his head back and banged his fists on the couch. [REDACTED] started saying, "I don't understand why won't you do this?" [REDACTED] said his reaction was scary for simply telling him no, that he cannot have sex with her when she tells him no. [REDACTED] said it was like he was having a meltdown. [REDACTED] then abruptly left her apartment because he thought his family returned home. [REDACTED] did her night time routine and got into bed when she received a call from [REDACTED] stating that he was downstairs and asked her to let him inside. He told her it was a false alarm, and that he was back to stay the night. [REDACTED] reminded him that she didn't tell him he could stay the night. He ended up staying at her house until around 4:00AM. [REDACTED] stated throughout the night, he continued to try and touch her and initiate sex after she stated no, and eventually he stopped.

Around that same time, late September/early October, [REDACTED] had visited her apartment unannounced and surprised her. [REDACTED] had tried to kiss her, and she told him no. [REDACTED] was getting ready to leave to go somewhere, and he got angry that she wouldn't get dressed in front of him.

At some point in late October of 2025, [REDACTED] went out to dinner with another female [REDACTED] and lied to [REDACTED] about it. [REDACTED] told him he shouldn't be doing that with [REDACTED], and was worried that he might be pressuring other [REDACTED] like he does with her. [REDACTED] told him she was angry with him, and the next day he showed up suddenly at her apartment with flowers and candy and asked for another chance. [REDACTED] stated that was the last time he showed up to her apartment.

Around the time of Halloween, [REDACTED] called [REDACTED] and told him not to speak to her again and not to contact her, and the following days he continued to call her several times and she eventually blocked him on all social media platforms and his phone number. A few weeks later, he somehow found her personal email, and sent her an email asking her to call him.

I asked about the previous times where [REDACTED] had come over to her house before work, and [REDACTED] stated there was one time that he did come over in the morning and they had consensual sex. It occurred before he went on vacation.

[REDACTED] also stated that many people in the prosecutor's office were aware of [REDACTED] odd behavior, and made comments about it. She stated it was sort of a running joke through the office that [REDACTED] calls her "the fun girl".

There were no witnesses to any of the sexual assault incidents. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] never offered her any rewards or promises regarding her career, and he never threatened her with discipline. [REDACTED] did state that there was a time in August where he had mentioned he would like her to be [REDACTED], as his [REDACTED] was leaving soon. [REDACTED] did mention that she had the potential to make more money [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated the thing that sticks out to her the most and what scared her the most is how emotional he would get when she told him no. [REDACTED] stated it was scary to her, and quite jarring the way that he would react. [REDACTED] stated throughout the year it went back and forth were there were times it seemed fine, and then other times it would go downhill. [REDACTED] was in [REDACTED] often and wanted to keep it civil between them.

In regards to communication, [REDACTED] stated he would call and text her all day while she was at work and whenever he was not [REDACTED]. There were times she felt it affected her daily life whether at home or at work.

[REDACTED] and I filled out a VRR form together and I concluded our interview.
